QUALIFICATIONS:

RELATION TO EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The position provides time for practice in tutoring, connecting students with resources, and learning how best to communicate with and support students from diverse backgrounds. RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assisting with administration of program through mailings, basic office tasks, and filing.

SALARY/STIPEND: \$3500 per semester
