Retention Rates

Freshmen (1st-Year Retention Rates by Major) and Transfer Retention

Data is disaggregated by program and gives retention rates for students starting as freshmen and those starting as transfer students in years 2017/18, 2018/19, and 2019/20. The data show that the 1-year retention rates for those students who started education programs as freshmen and who remain in their education programs exceed the retention rates of the college as a whole and of those not in education programs by about 15 percentage points across all three cycles of data. Retention rates of transfer students in education majors still tend to exceed those of transfer students in non-education programs and of those of the college as a whole, but by smaller percentages (5-10%). Similarly, retention rates of non-white candidates who start as freshmen tend to be higher than those of the college and of the students enrolled in a non-education major, but only by 2-5%.
