The first full assessment of this program is being conducted during 2016-2017. All assessment artifacts identified below will be collected at the end of the fall and spring semesters. Rubrics (in development) for each outcome will be applied to each artifact as outlined below (e.g. rubrics for outcomes 1, 3, 5, and 11 will be used with the HLH 650 Culminating Activity Project) by the M.S. Community Health Assessment Committee. Recommendations arising from the program assessment will be brought to the department for discussion by the committee. This program assessment is 1) examining student achievement of program outcomes, 2) pilot testing assessment rubrics, and 3) exploring/confirming the appropriateness of the "assessment opportunities" in measuring the program outcome(s) for which it is associated. Once this initial full program assessment has been completed it is anticipated that assessment of this program will go on a 3 year cycle with 2 assessments being conducted and discussed each year and a full review and discussion every 6 years.
