NOTES:

- This advisement guide has been developed in collaboration with representatives from SUNY Cortland, for the purpose of helping students meet FLCC graduation requirements while preparing for transfer to SUNY Cortland. The recommendations may include courses which are beyond the minimum requirements for FLCC graduation. Students are responsible for ensuring that their course selection meets requirements for FLCC graduation as well as those of SUNY Cortland. For information about minimum FLCC graduation requirements, see the FLCC catalog or your academic advisor. For information about SUNY Cortland requirements, check their website at www2.cortland.edu/home/.
- Completed courses with grades of C- or better are eligible to transfer. Courses with a "D" grade are eligible to transfer with a completed AA or AS degree.
- FLCC students who have graduated from the AS degree with the required GPA will transfer with full junior status. The SUNY Cortland General Education requirements will be waived. Students will still need to fulfill the SUNY GE requirements to obtain the bachelors degree. SUNY Cortland recommends that FLCC students complete a minimum of seven SUNY Gen Ed.s.
- The SUNY Cortland B.A. degree requires foreign language proficiency through the Intermediate Level II (level 202), the equivalent of four semesters. FLCC students are advised to begin a foreign language prior to transfer to ensure on time graduation.
- Half of the credits in the major and concentration and a minimum of 30 hours of course work must be completed in residency at SUNY Cortland.
