SOC 372 ANT 372 Gender Sexuality Ethnicity and Violence	Overlap issue here is significant, e.g. comments from WST, HIS, PHI, POL etc. It might be best to canvass all chairs on campus for a comment. Q8 needs clarity. If this is a cross listed course, follow the instructions per Q8. If this is not cross listed pick either ANT or SOC as the prefix. Follow the curriculum guide regarding how to state a cross list in a course description. Not clear if there is a prerequisite course. Adjust catalog description to address the prereq (assuming it exists). Frequency code missing, credit hours missing and cross list statement missing... catalog description lacks key elements. Use NOTES to identify this as a category B course. Q4 says “NO” but this course is apparently an adjustment of category B (alteration of program needed). Syllabus needs a new catalog description.
