The resource question (hiring new faculty) is explicitly the responsibility of the dean. No overlap here with museum studies course.

VOTE: unanimous decision to contingent pass, pending resolution of issues. One week for department to resolve this.

••• New Course Proposal: HIS 270 Digital History

Same issues as 270 above: freq code, prereq statement, restriction statement and credit hours. All CAPS not needed on the form. The outline has a different course description than that on the form. There is potential for overlap with digital/new media courses in Comm Studies --- consultation needed. Justification needs some clarification re the History dimension of this course.
