


Instructions to Complete Entrance Counseling

Step 1: Go to www.studentloans.gov



Step 2: Click on the Blue Log-In Button.

If you are **unable** to see the blue button or the page does not load properly it may be the internet browser you're using. Try using Internet 7 or Mozilla (Fire Fox). Unfortunately, the Federal Direct Loan website is not compatible with several internet browsers.



Step 3: Sign in with your FSAID and password.

If you do not remember it, click "Forgot Username or Password?" to retrieve your FSAID username and/or password.


