IMPORTANT: Spanish language courses from VENZ 1001 through VENZ 3021 are offered regardless of enrollment **if** the student requests the course at least one month prior to the program start date. Other courses are offered according to enrollment and thus require a minimum of 3-5 students. Depending upon enrollment, it may be necessary to merge certain classes. All courses are taught in Spanish unless otherwise specified. Student must check equivalencies with home institution. **Course descriptions are listed in the student handbook & at VEN-USA's WEB site: www.venusacollege.org.** When determining prerequisites for courses, we assume that students start in the first semester of beginning Spanish at the college-level. Therefore, when we list "2 years of college level Spanish" as a prerequisite,

students should calculate whether or not they have completed the equivalent Spanish courses (through the end of the second year), taking into account whether or not they tested at or above that level and received credit without actually completing the regular coursework.

Semester term(s): 12-15 credits maximum each term (17 max for UM students)

Summer session(s): 6-8 credit maximum each session (10 max for UM students)

Please note: All SUNY Cortland students must take a minimum of 12 credits during a semester term and 6 credits per summer session.
