\* All withdrawal requests must be received by the Registrar's office before the end of normal/summer business hours or they will be processed (and dated) the next business day. Most administrative offices are closed May 29, 2017 and July 4, 2017. Summer hours (Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.) are scheduled for May 15, 2017 through August 18, 2017.

\*\*The first day that classes are offered, as scheduled by the campus, shall be considered the first day of the semester, quarter or other term, and the first week of classes for purposes of this section shall be deemed to have ended when seven calendar days, including the first day of classes, have ended.
