Study Abroad Scholarships
Award Amounts: from \$1,000 to \$1,500

The Clark Center for International Education awards five groups of scholarships each year: the **Willi A. Uschald Scholarships**, the **Overseas Academic Program (OAP) Scholarships**, the **Gail Reed '67 Scholarship**, the **Charles A. Gibson Scholarship** and the **Kevin A. Rowell '83 Scholarships**. These scholarships are to promote participation in semester or year-long study abroad programs sponsored by SUNY or other accredited institutions. **(Several Uschald awards are available for summer programs that grant at least 6 credits. Several Wintersession OAP scholarships are also available. Separate application forms are available for these.)** Rowell awards are not available for summer. No more than 25% of the Uschald scholarships available in any one academic year will be available for study in English-speaking countries. (This rule may be waived if there are insufficient eligible applicants for foreign language programs.)

Students may apply for all the scholarships for which they meet the minimum criteria; however, an applicant may receive no more than one award. The standard amount for the Reed, Uschald and OAP awards is \$1,000; the standard award for the Gibson scholarship is \$1,150; the standard award for the Rowell Scholarships is \$1,500. **Students applying to non-Cortland programs are responsible for ensuring that all application materials are sent to Cortland's Clark Center for International Education in a timely fashion. STUDENTS MUST FILE A FAFSA BY MARCH 31 OR RISK BEING INELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS WHERE FINANCIAL NEED IS A REQUIREMENT. APPLICANTS FOR FALL SCHOLARSHIPS WILL NOT BE NOTIFIED UNTIL JUNE, DUE TO THE PROCESSING TIME FOR FAFSA INFORMATION.**
