☉ EXPLORING CHOICES FOR FUTURE CAREERS - July 18: For Students In Grades 10-12 (2016-2013)

An introduction to the lifelong learning process of career planning: Gain an understanding of *career and major choices*, plus the *skills and education* needed to pursue them. Using various *career resources* (including a *career interest inventory*), you'll create a list of careers/majors tailored to *your* likes and interests, in this *educational and interactive* program.

☉ SAT PRACTICE TEST - July 23 and/or Aug. 1 (2 sessions- attend one or both): For Students In Grades 9-12 (2016-2013)

A proctored full-length practice SAT (*approx. 4 hours*) will show students what to expect in a test-like environment. Students will receive a comprehensive analysis of their performance on the test, detailing individual strengths and weaknesses.

☉ GET THE SUCCESS FACTOR! - July 30: For Students Grades 10-12 (2015-2013)

What's that special "something" that makes for star-quality transition from high school to college?! This interactive session will mentor *10th-12th* graders to a deeper understanding of **what to expect** in terms of classes, teachers, studying, tests, grades, and even personal freedom.

☉ STUDY SKILLS July 24-25: For Students In Grades 8-10 (2017-2015)

Students will engage in a variety of enjoyable activities to enhance their *study skills* and *learning success*. Topics are: self-awareness; learning styles; time management; ways to organize ideas/notes, test taking strategies and reading comprehension.
