## **Convocation Address Speaker**



Dr. Laura J. Panning Davies *Professor, English* 

Dr. Laura J. Panning Davies is a prolific writer, dedicated educator and trusted administrator who has built programs to support students' growth as writers and learners. She is a respected scholar in the field of writing studies and has published widely on writing teacher pedagogy, student composing and reading practices, theories and practices of writing program administration, and histories of composition and rhetoric.

Davies, a professor in the English Department, joined the SUNY Cortland faculty in 2014 as an assistant professor and director of campus writing programs. In that role, she was responsible for curriculum development, assessment and faculty development in the SUNY Cortland first-year writing program and writing across the curriculum programs.

In 2021, she was selected to serve in the President's Cabinet, the highest level of campus leadership, in the critical position of chief of staff. Davies was a key advisor to the president on planning, decision-making and problem resolution. She advanced the president's leadership agenda through coordinated planning with the senior management team and collaborative working relationships with committees at all levels of the campus.

In 2022, she joined the author team for *They Say/I Say with Readings* (W. W. Norton & Co.), a best-selling first-year writing textbook used in thousands of college and high school classrooms across the United States. She also returned to the faculty as a professor in the English Department.

Davies holds a B.A. in history and English from Le Moyne College, an M.S.T. in English from the University of New Hampshire and a Ph.D. in composition and cultural rhetoric from Syracuse University.
