## Raquette Lake Summer Alumni Camp 2024 Antlers

Enjoy a memorable summer experience in the heart of the Adirondack Mountains. Registration forms for the summer sessions will be processed beginning Monday, Feb. 5, 2024. A variety of choices of four or seven-day stays are being offered. Activities include canoeing, hiking, kayaking, relaxing, star gazing, games, campfires, silk-screening (bring a t-shirt, pillowcase, shorts, etc.), and much more. Recreational equipment available for use during the summer session includes canoes, kayaks, SUP's and adult-size bikes. Yard games and beach toys are also available near the main office.

Arrival time is 2-4 p.m. on your arrival date. An all camp orientation will be held at 5 p.m., and dinner will be served at 6 p.m. Guests will depart after breakfast on the last day of your session.

**LODGING**: Guests will be assigned to housing according to family size and needs. Showers and bathrooms are located in most rooms. Bring your pillow and a light sleeping bag or sheets and blankets. Bed linens and towels must also be provided by all participants. All guests are required to keep rooms in a neat and orderly condition and to leave them in "as good, or better" condition, as there are no janitorial services available. Cleaning supplies and equipment are provided.

**MEALS**: All meals will be served in the Cummings Dining Hall. Breakfast will be served buffet-style between 7:45-8:30 a.m., and lunch (12 noon) and dinner (6 p.m.) will be served family style. Every effort is made to provide tasty, nutritionally balanced meals. If you or someone in your party has special dietary needs please let us know as soon as possible.

**PHONE**: A single telephone is available at Antlers and is used for business and emergency purposes only. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, the phone number is 315-354-4631. Cell phone service has improved somewhat over the years. AT&T, TRAC phones and wireless phone services currently have the best service.

Families are responsible for the safety and well-being of their own children. There are no babysitters or lifeguards on site. Families should provide their own child sized life jackets. Due to the setting of Antlers, family pets are <u>NOT</u> permitted.

A \$50 deposit is required when a confirmation email has been sent from our office – Outdoor Education. The deposit will be applied to the total cost and will be non-refundable unless a three-week notice of cancellation is given. Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. You will be expected to pay any balance upon arrival either online (preferably) or with a check **payable to SUNY Cortland**. *Please note that we do not prorate the costs for partial stays*.
