

Scholarships Overview

- SUNY Cortland has over 250
 unique scholarships funded
 through the Cortland College
 Foundation by donors.
- Scholarships have unique selection criteria decided by the donors.
- Student's must apply to these scholarships through Academic Works.



Scholarship Timeline



- November 15, 2022
 - Scholarship Application Portal opens
- February 1, 2023
 - Scholarship Application Deadline
- February 3, 2023 March 1, 2023
 - Committees review applicants and select recipients
- March 1, 2023 April 1, 2023
 - Recipients are notified via E-mail and funds are posted to recipients financial aid package
- Fall Term 2023
 - First half of scholarship funds are distributed
- Spring Term 2024
 - Second half of scholarship funds are distributed

Nontraditional Students

- Here at SUNY Cortland, we consider non-traditional undergraduate students as:
 - at least 24 years or older OR
 - those students who, regardless of age, have dependent children OR
 - have had an interruption or delay in their education since high school OR
 - any students who do not feel they fit in with the traditional undergraduate student body



Nontraditional Student Scholarships


