Ticket Sales Information (Call Campus Activities Office if have questions -- 607-753-5574):

- Ticket price includes round trip bus transportation and theater ticket but not any meals
- SUNY Cortland ID is required. Students may purchase ONE (1) additional student ticket for another SUNY Cortland student ONLY IF THEY HAVE THE OTHER SUNY CORTLAND STUDENT'S ID CARD. If no SUNY Cortland ID is presented, the second ticket will be priced at the higher faculty/staff price.
- Cash or check (made payable to ASC) accepted as payment. No credit cards please.
- Bus leaves Corey Union at 7 am, arriving in NYC typically around 11:30 am
- Bus leaves NYC at 8 pm and arrives back at Corey Union between 12 midnight and 1 am
- One stop made on way down so people can buy breakfast (30 minutes) and one quick stop on way back (vending machines/bathroom break/stretch legs)
