

Introduction August 2023

The class of 2022* enters the workforce two years after the global Covid -19 pandemic devastated the world of work. Graduates from this class enter the world as we slowly enter post-covid normalcy. The labor market remains strong for recent graduates; however, the economy is still in decline as inflation is steadily increasing.

As we begin to transition into the expectations of a post-pandemic world, we are seeing labor transition into a new normal. Fully virtual and remote work opportunities are becoming less frequent, and hybrid configurations seem firmly established. Meanwhile, traditional in-person work is largely returning to pre-pandemic norms. Our graduates are having success in finding employment opportunities after graduation; however, the post-pandemic world of work is steadily changing how they grow their careers.

Some graduates are reporting difficulty finding employment in their fields, while some have opted to go back to school in lieu of finding a job. The 2022* class continued last year's trend of an increasing percentage of students pursuing graduate school. This trend could be the result of the declining economy, as economic downturns often see an increase in enrollment in higher education to increase employability and thus earning potential. One interesting development that has resulted from the effects of the pandemic is our graduates' increased mobility after graduation.

Last year's first destinations and graduate outcomes report began to show some intriguing trends with students' employment after graduation. This year's survey has produced similar results. Some graduates from the class of 2022* have held two to three professional positions over one year after graduation. Interestingly, many of these positions represent significant career changes. Twenty (20) percent of graduates that find employment after graduation (90 out of 423) have had at least two professional positions in one year.

A few graduates have been promoted within two years of employment; for example, one graduate began working as a recruiter and then was promoted to a senior recruiting associate. Other graduates have completed an entire career change within two years of working. For example, one graduate began working as an upper elementary school teacher and then transitioned to work as a recruiting coordinator. While we still do not have enough data to fully explain or analyze this trend, it seems traditional career trajectories and norms are changing. More graduates are trying to work in line with their undergraduate major and end up transitioning to fields that may be inclusive of other skills and interests. This points to a need to transition away from first destinations reporting relative only to major to career mobility tracking. Career mobility tracking can provide insight into how a college degree aids in the life-long career development process.

Career Services continues to provide valuable programming and coaching to students and alumni to aid them in building a bridge between their education and the world of work. Skill development is a vital tool for students to be able to transition across employment opportunities while building their careers. As terms of employment shorten for our graduates, SUNY Cortland must continue to educate students on developing their transferable skills in all disciplines as part of career and self-development.

Thank you to our faculty and staff for all the big and small ways you help our students and alumni to not only find jobs or graduate programs but also for helping them find meaning and purpose. Your work matters for our students, our graduates, and for this moment in history.


