Introduction

The class of 2021* represents a unique moment in history. This class entered the workforce a year after the impacts of the labor market turmoil and global shutdown caused by COVID-19 pandemic. The negative effects of the pandemic on post-graduation plans decreased dramatically for the class of 2021* compared to the class of 2020.

As the world, and the world of work begin to return to 'normalcy,' we are seeing interesting changes in the labor market. Virtual and remote work opportunities are still available, and some traditionally in-person work is still remote. Our graduates are having success in finding employment opportunities after graduation, however, the effects of the pandemic on the world of work have not disappeared.

A few graduates are reporting difficulty finding employment in their fields, while some have opted to go back to school in lieu of finding a job. The 2021* class saw an increase in the percentage of students pursuing graduate school. This trend could be the result of the recent pandemic, as economic downturns often see an increase in enrollment in higher education to increase employability. One interesting development that has resulted from the effects of the pandemic is our graduates' increased mobility after graduation.

In prior first destinations and graduate outcomes reports, the College had not been collecting information on graduates' transition from one job to another within the first year. This year's survey has produced some intriguing trends with students' employment after graduation. Some graduates from the class of 2021* have held two to three professional positions over a year after graduation.

Some graduates have been promoted within two years of employment; for example, one graduate began working as an Inside Sales Manager and then was promoted to Regional Sales Manager-Canada and Latin America. Other graduates have completed an entire career change within two years of working. For example, one graduate began working as a Copywriter and then transitioned to work as a Junior Network Specialist. Unfortunately, currently we do not have enough data on this trend to provide further insight. However, this trend may point to a need to transition away from first destinations reporting to career mobility tracking. Career mobility tracking can provide insight into how a college degree aids in the life-long career development process.

Career Services continues to provide valuable programming and advising to students to aid students in building a bridge between their education and the world of work. Skill development is a vital tool for students to be able to transition between employment opportunities while building their career. As terms of employment shorten for our graduates, SUNY Cortland must continue to educate students on developing their transferrable skills within all disciplines as part of career and self-development.

Thank you to our faculty and staff for all the big and small ways you help our students and alumni to find not only jobs or graduate programs, but also meaning and purpose. Your work matters for our students, our graduates, and for this moment in history.



First Destinations Totals Undergraduate Class of 2021




