



## **2017 STUDY ABROAD PHOTO CONTEST GUIDELINES**

**Eligibility:** To take part in this contest you must have studied abroad between Fall 2016 – Summer 2017.

**Contest Categories:**

- 1) The World as Your Classroom: academic insights gained outside of a traditional classroom
- 2) Cortland Abroad: photos of Cortland students abroad (wearing Cortland logos or a cutout of Blaze are a plus!)
- 3) Culture & Customs: capture unique cultural comparisons or observations
- 4) A Different Perspective: landscapes and cityscapes and mindscapes that changed your perspective
- 5) Global Headlines: newsworthy topics you observed firsthand

**Number and Format of Submissions:** You may submit up to five photos – one per contest category. Each photo must be submitted electronically via our online application (see below). Photos may be black-and-white or color.

**Restrictions:** Photo(s) must be appropriate for posting on a public website. Obscene, provocative or otherwise questionable content will not be considered. SUNY Cortland retains sole discretion as to what constitutes inappropriate content. All photo contest entries become the property of the Cortland International Programs Office. By submitting your photo(s), you permit the Internationals Programs Office to use them to promote programs in print or electronic media.

**Photo Release Form:** Photo(s) containing recognizable people (other than yourself) must be accompanied by a signed [SUNY Cortland Photo Release](#) form. This (especially) includes photos of: children; people with disabilities; people with minoritized identities (racial, ethnic, religious, etc.); and people who are economically and/or educationally disadvantaged. If you cannot provide a release form for a person in one of your photos, you should choose a different photo to submit for that particular category. If you provide a release form, you will have the option to upload in our online application.

**Application Process and Deadline:** You must submit your photograph(s), via our online application – which is accessed via this link: <https://goo.gl/forms/uKZRZblNYFcWUAc22>  
ENTRIES ARE DUE BY **October 20, 2017**.

**First, Second, and Third place winners in each category will be announced during International Education Week (Nov 13- 17, 2017) – and photos will be displayed on campus that week!**
