Administrative Update

- Admissions will be releasing names of accepted students for Fall 2023
 - o Reinforce that is important to reach out to these students
 - We had 11,000 applicants and we accepted more than we can take
- SUNY Print Initiative goal to reduce printing and number of printers
 - Lisa will be visiting office spaces
 - Reminder to be mindful of your printing
 - o English has some concerns with 40 faculty on two floors sharing one printer
- Van Hoesen renovation will get underway at the end of semester should be ready for occupancy January 2026
- Telecommuting hasn't been an issue for most departments, administrative assistants are not eligible (because offices should be open)
- Undergraduate Research Council applications for summer fellowships are open
 - o Twelve fellowships available and maybe more will open up
 - In the past they have been short on applications please encourage faculty to talk with students
 - Question about housing cut off money for housing, is that this year or next?
- Room requests please be reasonable
 - o Bring up legitimate needs now, not 2-3 weeks into the semester

New Business

Blackboard to Brightspace LMS transition

- Remind faculty that this is the last semester for BB; summer classes will be in Brightspace
 - o Access will be maintained for a while
 - o They will help transfer courses to Brightspace
- Training is available for Brightspace

Course merge procedures

- If a faculty is teaching more than one section of same course they can merge sections into one space in LMS at the SUNY level there is a concern about this because of FERPA
- Workaround for this requires supervisory approval
 - Does this include cross-listed courses? -- probably
 - Ouestion about email being disabled, is that for the whole class?
 - O Question about the merging being prohibited after student activity in the course?
 - Question about notifying the class about sections being merged? -- this is more about notification to students so they know where to go for the class

Fall 2023 course scheduling

- Appointments with Bruce are filling up fast
- Going back to submitting schedule with a spreadsheet no longer using course creator
- Temporary service forms are helpful to track what we do
- Cross-listed courses with Africana Studies use a two-year plan for scheduling
 - o Provide a plan of what you plan to do in the next two years
- Request last week to move a class to Brown Auditorium if faculty wants to use Brown Auditorium consider another room

New SUNY General Education framework

- Minimal amount of time to implement changes, start in Fall 2023 catalog
- SLOs have been adjusted, most are fine, three categories with significant changes
 - GE 6, 8, and 11 if your department teaches in these areas fill out form with a decision about staying in the category
 - o Is there any anticipation about meeting the Feb. 11 deadline? -- no

Open Discussion

- Math is advertising for a search and two members of department make less than the initial salary of the search there is a recognition that to be successful we need to be competitive
 - College will continue to address salary inequity; corrections will not necessarily be addressed within a given year
- For searches:
 - o maximum to bring to campus is three
 - Not a requirement for two people to travel to the airport to pick up a candidate
- Pool for part-time hires is very small
