# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN SUNY CORTLAND B.S.Ed. IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION

# FULTON MONTGOMERY COMMUNITY COLLEGE A.S. IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORT STUDIES

## I. General State of Purpose:

This document establishes a formal transfer agreement between Fulton Montgomery Community College, A.S., Physical Education and Sport Studies and SUNY Cortland's B.S.Ed, Physical Education.

# II. Objectives:

- A. To create a seamless transfer process for students from Fulton Montgomery to SUNY Cortland;
- B. To attract highly qualified students to both colleges.

### III. Eligibility/Admission Requirements:

- A. Fulton Montgomery Community College students must complete an Associate in Science (A.S.) Degree in Physical Education and Sport Studies before entrance into the SUNY Cortland Physical Education program;
- B. Fulton Montgomery Community College students must meet the academic requirements for admission to SUNY Cortland, including specific course work as outlined in this proposal;
- C. We recommend that Fulton Montgomery Community College students complete a minimum of seven of the ten SUNY General Education requirements;
- D. Fulton Montgomery Community College students must complete the SUNY Cortland application process.

#### IV. Benefits/Advantages:

- A. Junior status for degree and financial aid purposes;
- B. Waiver of the Cortland General Education requirements (not SUNY GE requirements);
- C. Guidelines for completion of program at SUNY Cortland and direct contact for advisement to promote an easier transition for qualified students.
