ACADEMIC ADVISING

Provides professional advising for undeclared students; answers questions for all students on choosing a major, selecting courses, degree planning and academic challenges

NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

A program students attend prior to their first semester that introduces services and strategies vital to their successful transition

TRANSFER CREDIT SERVICES

Evaluates credits for incoming students and approves coursework that current students take at other colleges during summer and winter

STARFISH

An online tool that offers early and ongoing feedback regarding academic progress
