Housing

On-Campus Residence Halls

\$ 4,030 (double) - \$4,735 (single). Students living in on-campus Residence Halls must purchase a meal plan.

Leadership House (must be enrolled at SUNY Cortland for at least 2 semesters Fall and Spring)

\$3,800 (private room) - will share the house with 8-10 other students and are not required to purchase a meal plan.

West Campus Apartments

Meal Plans

At SUNY Cortland, the Silver plan is mandatory for all first semester freshman, transfer and Exchange students. The Silver On-Campus Students: (College policy makes meal plans mandatory for these students)

Silver	\$2,320	unlimited Neubig/Bistro meals per week + 5 guest passes + \$225 Dragon Dollars
Bronze	\$2,255	unlimited Neubig/Bistro meals per week + 5 guest passes + \$125 Dragon Dollars
Copper	\$2,155	unlimited Neubig/Bistro meals per week + 5 guest passes + \$25 Dragon Dollars

Meals can be eaten at Neubig/Bistro Dining Center where you can have all-you-care-to-eat of any of the variety of foods offered (best value). Meals can also be eaten at any of our twelve other unique dining locations on-campus.

The following dollar amounts have been determined as a Meal Equivalent at our other dining facilities:

Breakfast	\$6.75	(7:30 am – 10:30 am)
Lunch	\$8.00	(10:30 am – 3:00 pm)
Dinner	\$9.75	(4:00 pm – 8:00 pm)

If you purchase above the dollar amount for the Meal Equivalent, you may use your Dragon Dollars to make up the Off-campus students: (including West Campus)

Meal plans are not mandatory for off-campus students, but you may find one convenient, since you will often be on campus at meal times. If you are interested in a plan you may choose any meal plan listed above, use one of our Commuter Plans, or Connections Account described below.

Commuter Plans: (available to Off-campus and West Campus Students only)

Olympic	\$1,210	100 meals per semester + 5 guest passes + 450 Dragon Dollars
Collegiate	\$980	75 meals per semester + 5 guest passes + 400 Dragon Dollars
Recreational	\$720	50 meals per semester + 5 guest pass + 350 Dragon Dollars

Connections Account

All Students Need A Connections Account all laundry machines in all on-campus housing and West Campus can be used ONLY with an ID card that has a Connections account (no coins). The account can also be used for purchases at the College Bookstore, Campus Corner grocery store, dining facilities, copy/print services and in vending machines.

A minimum of \$25 is needed to open this account. Any amount may then be added at any time.
