Virtual Course: Ecotourism with Kibbutz Lotan Center for Creative Ecology

This summer, embark with Professor Ken Cohen from Recreation, Parks & Leisure Studies, on a virtual intercultural learning adventure with the Center for Creative Ecology at Kibbutz Lotan, Israel. Students from across majors and disciplines will address environmental practices, such as renewable energy systems and permaculture, diverse cultural impacts on ecotourism practices, and the potential for regional economic opportunities via shared natural and cultural capital.



This course will include virtual sessions with Israeli, Palestinian, Bedouin, Jordanian, and Egyptian tourism operations key stakeholders. Discussions will focus on community capacity building as a foundational strategy for ecotourism development, and how the <u>U.N.</u> <u>Sustainable Development Goals</u> are being addressed at the regional level with respect to environmental conservation and equitable economic development strategies.
