

Student Accounts Information Release Form: FERPA

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA), also known as the Buckley Amendment, prohibits access to any student records by any third party including parents, with certain limited exceptions, unless the student gives written authorization. For student protection and privacy, all billing and financial information is privileged.

The student may grant SUNY Cortland permission to release information concerning their financial account information to a third party (including parents, grandparents, etc.) by submitting this completed FERPA form. You must identify each individual person to whom you wish to grant access/information regarding your financial record.

This form is only for financial account information only and is not the same as an *Authorized Payer*
