SPEAK WITH YOUR ADVISOR Meet with your advisor to verify eligibility for graduation.	Now through March 1
APPLY FOR YOUR DEGREE To graduate, you must apply for degree conferral regardless of participation in Commencement. Visit the Registrar's Office website to review the application timelines. The degree conferral application is located in myRedDragon. After logging in to myRedDragon: 1. Select Student tab and go to the Registrar channel. 2. Under "Degree and Conferral Information," select Undergraduate or Graduate Degree Application. You must apply by March 1 or your name will not appear in the printed commencement program. 3. At the prompt for Commencement participation, indicate whether you plan to attend a ceremony.	Now through March 1
UNDERGRADUATE CEREMONY ASSIGNMENT Ceremony assignments are based on the department of your primary major. Visit cortland.edu/commencement to determine your ceremony.	Now through Commencement
GUEST TICKETS AND SPECIAL PERSON RECOGNITION Each student is guaranteed four guest tickets and one student line-up "Grad Pass" ticket. While reserving your tickets, you may provide the name(s) of anyone you would like to recognize. You may access this online form in the myRedDragon Commencement channel.	March 17 through April 18
CLEAR OUTSTANDING OBLIGATIONS/HOLDS Clear up any outstanding obligations/holds, such as library fees, parking tickets, etc. A diploma can only be issued after all obligations are cleared.	Before May 1
