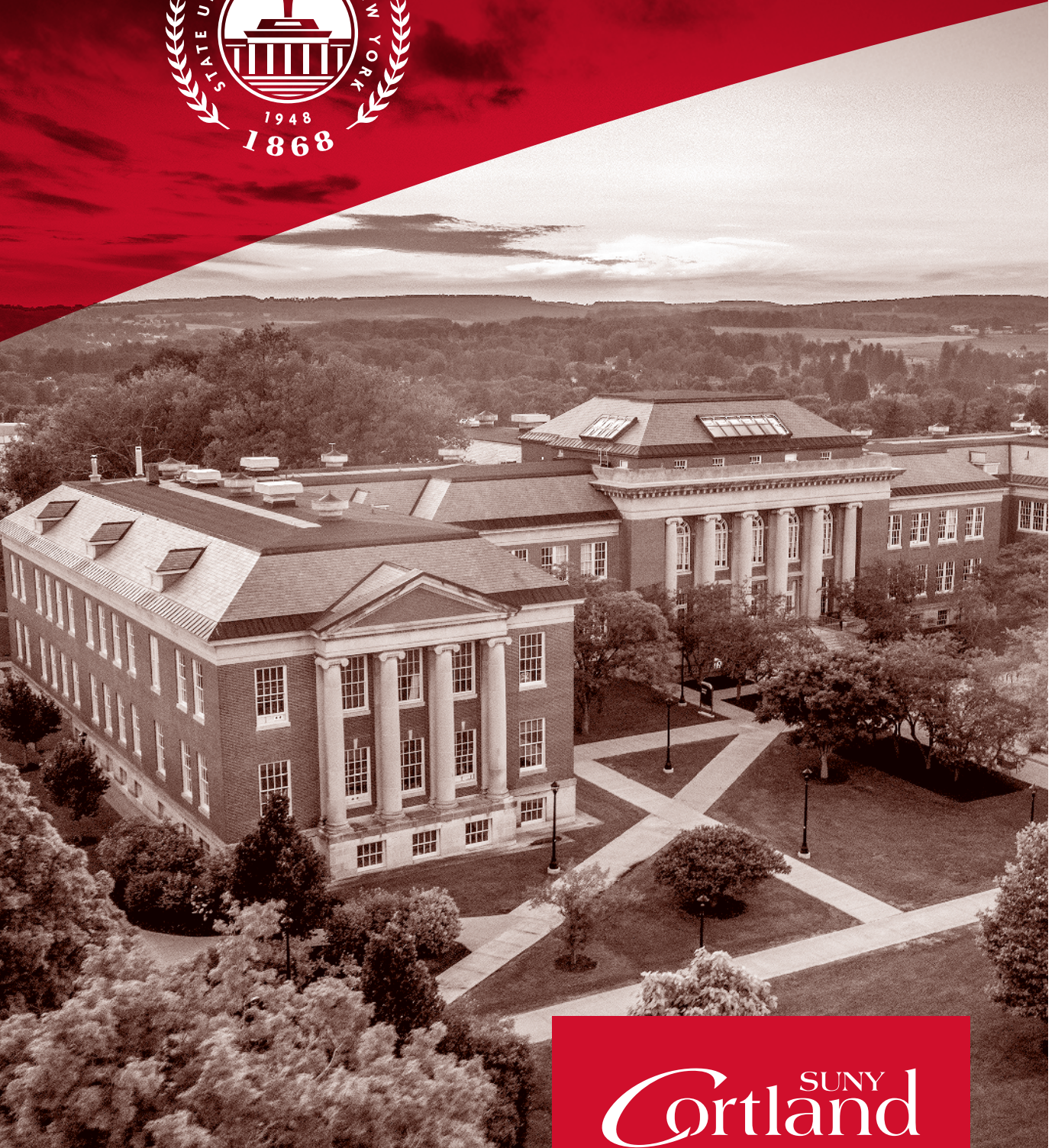

Commencement Speakers

DR. GIRISH BHAT
Ceremony A



Throughout an impressive 33-year career at SUNY Cortland, Professor Girish Bhat of the History Department has earned a

reputation for his extraordinary teaching ability and a commitment to international education.

Bhat holds an M.A. and Ph.D. in history from the University of California, Berkeley, and a B.A. in history from Southern Methodist University.

At Cortland, he has mentored students from many disciplines at various points of their college experience, from first-year learning communities to graduate-level research seminars. A specialist in Russian history, Bhat has offered more than a dozen course titles on topics spanning law, the history of women in Europe and the Silk Road. He also served as the coordinator of the Honors Program from 1995 to 1999.

Bhat's scholarship includes a series of peer-reviewed articles and published book reviews covering Russian law and judicial reform, Stalinism and the Soviet Union's role in the Vietnam War. A former editorial board member for *Law and History Review*, Bhat has presented conference papers and talks across the globe, including a three-seminar series on "The Rule of Law in Russian History" in Moscow in 2001.

Bhat has contributed to Cortland's study abroad efforts, particularly in southern India. Along with SUNY Distinguished Professor of Sociology/Anthropology Sharon Steadman, Bhat helped establish a continuing exchange partnership with St. Aloysius (Deemed to be University) in Mangalore.

His high level of instruction has been recognized with SUNY Cortland's Rozanne M. Brooks Dedicated Teacher Award in 2004 and the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching in 2010.

DR. DIANE L. GILL '70
Ceremony B



Diane L. Gill '70 stands out as a widely respected scholar in the field of sport and exercise psychology. A professor in

the Department of Kinesiology at the University of North Carolina Greensboro, her work as an educator and author has helped the world better understand the connection between physical and mental health.

After receiving a bachelor's degree in physical education from SUNY Cortland, Gill earned a master's degree and Ph.D. from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Throughout a career spanning more than 50 years, Gill's scholarship has covered more than 100 presentations and publications, including a highly regarded textbook, *Psychological Dynamics of Sport and Exercise*. This work has been lauded as fundamental within sport and exercise psychology.

Gill has served in an editor's role for the *Journal of Sport and Exercise Psychology* and the *Women in Sport and Physical Activity Journal*. She also previously led the North American Society for the Psychology of Sport and Physical Activity; the exercise and sport psychology division of the American Psychological Association; and the research consortium of American Alliance for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance.

In 1991, Gill was recognized with SUNY Cortland's Distinguished Alumna Award. She also served as the 2015 keynote speaker at "Transformations: A Student Research and Creativity Conference," Cortland's annual celebration of students' independent scholarly work.

The university's Dr. Diane L. Gill '70 Scholarship helps high-achieving students in the Kinesiology and Physical Education departments earn college degrees. Her commitment to well-being, teaching and scholarship exemplifies the values of our community.

DR. BETH KLEIN
Ceremony C



SUNY Distinguished Service Professor Beth Klein has transformed how SUNY Cortland engages with sustainability.

Her advocacy for many "green" initiatives is a major reason why the university earned silver honors from the Association for the Advancement of Sustainability in Higher Education (AASHE) in 2025 — becoming the first SUNY campus to be recognized in the newest national rating system.

A member of the Childhood/Early Childhood Education Department since 1999, Klein also serves as SUNY Cortland's sustainability coordinator. She holds a doctorate in science education from the University of Virginia, an M.S.Ed. in Reading from East Stroudsburg University and a B.S. in environmental and elementary education from Slippery Rock University.

Throughout her career, Klein has inspired the campus community to think deeply about topics that impact the well-being of the planet. She has served as the faculty coordinator of the W.H. Parks Family Center for Outdoor and Environmental Education, co-chair of the university's Sustainability Coalition and an active committee member for groups that include Campus Garden advisory, climate action planning and many other important causes.

Klein provides her teacher candidates with nature-based learning opportunities as they prepare to teach their own elementary and early childhood students in outdoor settings. In 2010, she received the New York State Outdoor Education Association Leadership Award to recognize innovative work to promote outdoor and environmental education.

Klein received the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Faculty Service in 2016. She earned the title of distinguished service professor, the SUNY system's highest academic rank, in 2024.

Academic Traditions

ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The processional begins with the all-university gonfalonier, who leads in the faculty, followed by the schools of Arts and Sciences, Education and Professional Studies gonfaloniers, who lead in the students. The processional concludes when the mace bearer brings in the platform party, which consists of members of the administration and faculty leadership, the College Council, visiting dignitaries and honorees.

THE MACE

The mace is a ceremonial staff used as a symbol of authority. The mace bearer precedes the platform party and places the mace on a special stand where it remains while the official proceedings of Commencement are underway. SUNY Cortland's mace, the "Torch of Learning," is made of silver and rosewood and was created by local silversmith John Marshall.

THE GONFALONS

The four bright banners carried in the academic procession are called gonfalons. The red, white, black and grey gonfalon represents SUNY Cortland; in blue, grey and burgundy it represents the School of Arts and Sciences; in blue, purple and black it represents the School of Education; and in peach and green it represents the School of Professional Studies.

The gonfalons were designed by Libby Kowalski, professor emerita of art and art history, and Kathy Maher '84. The standards were made by the late Bard Prentiss, associate professor emeritus of art and art history, and J. Eric Kroot. Materials were provided by the Gilbert and Mary Cahill Foundation and the late Rozanne M. Brooks, distinguished teaching professor emerita of sociology/anthropology.

REGALIA

Commencement lends itself to the pageantry of an academic procession rooted in medieval times. The gowns and hoods worn by faculty members, candidates for graduation and platform dignitaries distinguish the institution from which the wearer was or will be graduated, the level of the degree earned and the field of learning.

In 1985, American colleges established a standard code of academic dress, specifying three types of gowns. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves, the gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve with the front part cut in an arc, and the gown for the doctoral degree has bell-shaped sleeves. The doctoral gown also is trimmed in velvet. The hood's inner lining, which folds out at the back and center, indicates the colors of the institution granting the degree, while the border, which comes around to the front of the neck, represents the field of learning.

The black mortarboard cap is standard. Its only distinguishing feature is a gold tassel worn by holders of the doctoral degree.



PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The silver medallion worn by the president at Commencement was designed by the late Gerald DiGiusto, professor of art and art history, and crafted by artist Linda Stewart in a project supported by the late Rozanne M. Brooks, distinguished teaching professor emerita of sociology/anthropology. It depicts the seven valleys of Cortland County.

THE HONORS MEDALLION

The graduates wearing silver medallions with red ribbons have completed the SUNY Cortland Honors Program. To complete the Honors Program, a student must take 24 credit hours of honors courses, engage in 40 hours of community service, maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.2, and complete an honors thesis during their senior year.

THE KENTE STOLE

The Kente stole is a rich, multicolored, handwoven style of cloth that originated in Ghana, West Africa, and is revered throughout the Africana world. It is traditionally worn during important national ceremonies. The colors, patterns and ideogrammatic images of the Kente stole impart information about the wearer and highlight the importance of an event or a ceremony. Similar to the academic hood, the Kente stole is relatively new to commencement ceremonies in the United States and symbolizes higher education's connection to the rich cultures, intellectual traditions and academic achievements of the Africana world.

SPECIAL PERSON DESIGNATION

All graduates can designate a special person who has been instrumental in helping them achieve their higher education goals. This individual's name is read along with the graduate's name as they walk across the stage at the Commencement ceremony. Students who choose to name a special person do so when they apply for their degree.

INTERNATIONAL FLAG PRESENTATIONS

Graduating students representing countries from around the world have the opportunity to present their national flag to the provost during the Commencement ceremony. In the past, flags representing Afghanistan, Australia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Belize, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Cyprus, Egypt, Finland, France, Germany, Ghana, Grenada, Haiti, India, Iran, Ireland, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Kenya, Lebanon, Malaysia, Nepal, Nigeria, Peru, Poland, Republic of Congo, Romania, Russia, South Africa, South Korea, St. Lucia, Sweden, Thailand, The Gambia, Turkey and the United Kingdom were received. The 2025 ceremonies will feature the flags of Turks and Caicos, Ghana and Iran. Flags are displayed on stage during the ceremony and afterward they are exhibited in the lobby of Corey Union and the foyer of Old Main.

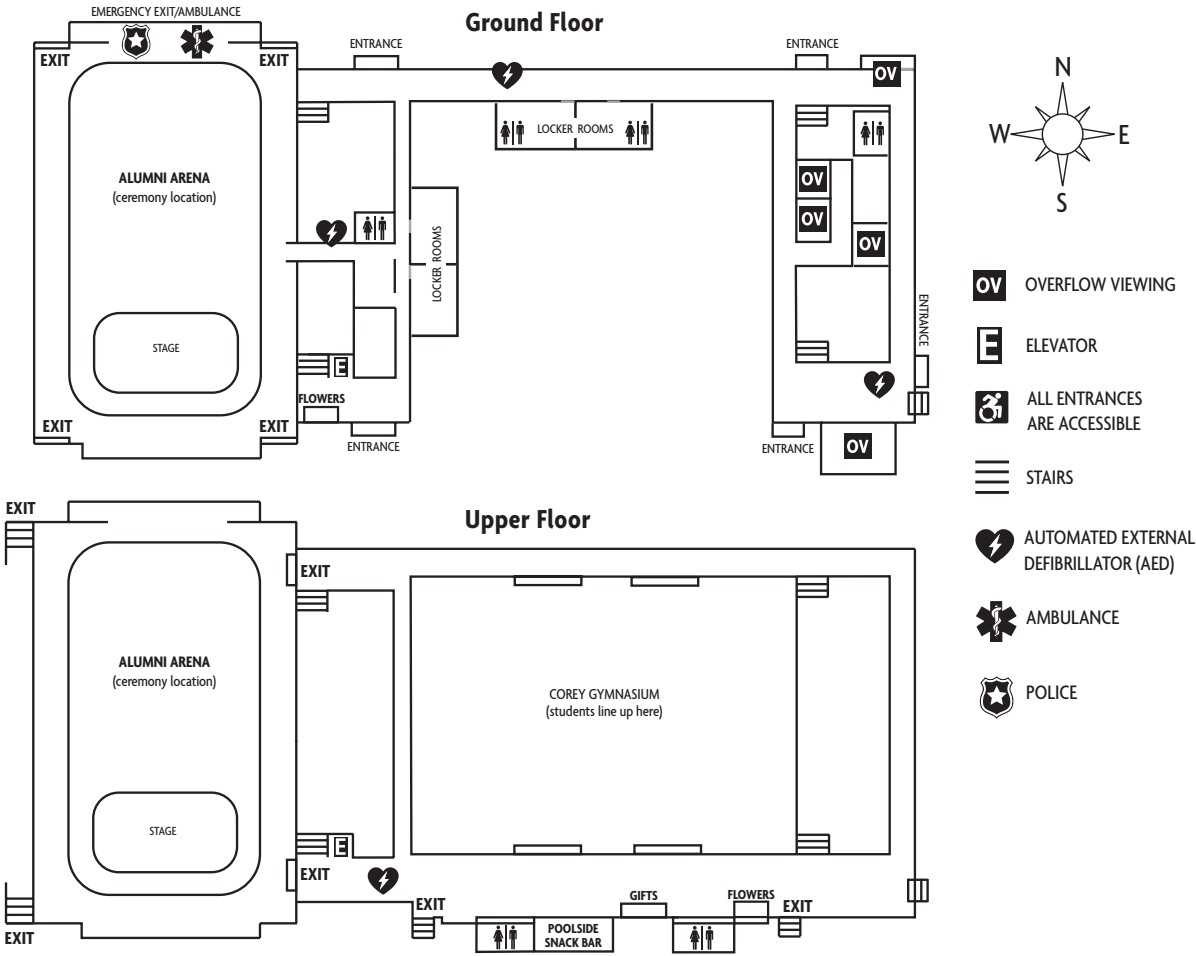
