

The following table shows faculty voting rights across all SUNY campuses. The University Centers are in bold and among them only Cortland and Old Westbury do not allow any kind of voting by non-tenure track faculty. Only 5 campuses in total do not allow any contingent voting and there is 1 unknown (Alfred State has no governance documents available for public review that could be located). All SUNY programs at Cornell are part of the Cornell Faculty Senate and so are grouped together.

This list was first created in 2022, but a final review to check for any changes was done in February 2025.
