## Raquette Lake Summer Alumni Camp 2025 Antlers

Thank you for your interest in joining us for a summer session at Antlers! *Please note* the dates of the sessions this season, and early registration and payment is encouraged to secure your spot. We have two sessions in July that will run from Thursday to Sunday. In late July and in August, we will have three of our usual full week sessions (Sunday-Saturday), and the half sessions (Sunday-Wednesday or Wednesday-Saturday). Families are responsible for the safety and well-being of their own children. There are no babysitters or lifeguards on site. Families should provide their own child sized life jackets. Due to the setting of Antlers, family pets are <u>NOT</u> permitted.

**LODGING**: Guests will be assigned to housing according to family size and needs. Bathrooms are located in most rooms (two rooms have private bathrooms in the adjacent hallway). Guests will need to bring a light sleeping bag or twin sheets, blankets, pillow, towels, and all bathroom necessities. All guests are required to keep rooms in a neat and orderly condition and to leave them in "as good, or better" condition, as there are no janitorial services available. Cleaning supplies and equipment are provided.

Arrival time is 3-4:30 p.m. on your arrival date. An all camp orientation will be held at 5 p.m., and dinner will be served at 6 p.m. Guests will depart after breakfast on the last day of your session.

MEALS: All meals will be served in the Cummings Dining Hall. Meals will be served buffet-style: breakfast between 7:45-8:30 a.m., lunch (12 noon) and dinner (6 p.m.). If you or someone in your party has special dietary needs please let us know on your registration forms. If you have needs after you submit your registration, please contact us at Antlers, 315-354-4631. Every effort is made to provide tasty, nutritionally balanced meals. A camp refrigerator is available in the Main Lodge for use by guests.

**Recreational equipment** available for use during the summer session includes canoes, kayaks, stand-up paddleboards and adult-size bikes. Yard games and beach toys are also available near the main office and on the volleyball field, and nature backpacks with activities for children are available in the office. Family oriented and full of fun, this vacation will keep you coming back each year.

Registrants will receive a Formstack confirmation once the form was received. Your registration will then be reviewed beginning February 3, 2025, and a confirmation email sent to you from our Outdoor Education office. <a href="Reservation and payment policies:">Reservation and payment policies:</a>

A \$100 deposit is required once your registration is confirmed by our office. If deposit is not received within 2 weeks of confirmation from the Outdoor Education office (NOT Formstack), your reservation will be removed. Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. Cancellations made at least 3 weeks PRIOR to your stay will receive a full refund of your deposit. Cancellations made within the 3 week window to your stay will NOT be refunded. Guests who do not show up for camp, and do not cancel, will be charged the session fee, and will not be allowed to return until the fee is paid. <a href="Please note that we do not prorate the costs for partial stays">Please make all checks payable to SUNY Cortland</a>.
