## Raquette Lake Creative Arts Camp @ Antlers August 24-27, 2025

Thank you for your interest in joining us for our Creative Arts Camp at Antlers! Everything artsy for four days in the company of other artists and crafters to share talents and instruction. We will have woodworking projects, create your own flower press, indigenous projects of dreamcatchers, journals or fairy houses, a sip & paint with acrylics, and more. We will supply everything needed, but feel free to bring your favorite craft equipment, current projects, or anything you would like to share and teach the group. The program will begin Sunday, August 24 at 7 p.m. with an introduction in the Main Lodge. Guests may arrive anytime after 2 p.m. and settle into camp. Guests may work on their own projects for the afternoon, or work on different things we will have available. On the last day of camp (Wednesday), we will provide lunch and allow guests to work through the afternoon on any projects they want to finish.

There will be recreational equipment available for use during the session, which includes canoes, kayaks, stand-up paddleboards, mountain bikes, yard games and beach toys.

<u>MEALS</u>: Meals will be provided in the Cummings Dining Hall beginning Monday morning at breakfast. Our last meal is lunch on Wednesday August 27. Please bring your own dinner Sunday to warm up in the Main Lodge kitchen, or a dish to pass for a pot-luck meal at 5 p.m. (in Main Lodge). All other meals are provided.

Meals will be served buffet-style: breakfast (8:00 a.m.), lunch (12 noon) and dinner (6 p.m.) beginning with breakfast Monday. If you or someone in your party has special dietary needs please let us know on your registration forms. If you have needs after you submit your registration, please contact us at Antlers, 315-354-4631. Every effort is made to provide tasty, nutritionally balanced meals. A camp refrigerator is also available in the Main Lodge for use by guests.

**LODGING**: Guests will be assigned to housing according to space and needs. Bathrooms are located in most rooms (two rooms have private bathrooms in the adjacent hallway). Guests will need to bring a light sleeping bag or twin sheets, blankets, pillow, towels, and all bathroom necessities. All guests are required to keep rooms in a neat and orderly condition and to leave them in "as good, or better" condition, as there are no janitorial services available. Cleaning supplies and equipment are provided. **Due to the setting of Antlers, family pets are NOT permitted.**

Registrants will receive a Formstack confirmation once the form was received. Your registration will then be reviewed and a confirmation email sent to you from our Outdoor Education office. *Reservation and payment policies:* A \$100 deposit is required once your registration is confirmed by our office. If deposit is not received within 2 weeks of confirmation from the Outdoor Education office (NOT Formstack), your reservation will be removed. Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. Cancellations made at least 3 weeks PRIOR to your stay will receive a full refund of your deposit. Cancellations made within the 3 week window to your stay will NOT be refunded. Guests who do not show up for camp, and do not cancel, will be charged the session fee, and will not be allowed to return until the fee is paid. *Please note that we do not prorate the costs for partial stays.* Please make all checks payable to SUNY Cortland.
