- Updates on graduate fellowships, we can nominate two students
- Updates on SLOs progress
- Summer orientation will be remote
- Online transformations starting on May 13
 - Deadline to upload is May 6
- Clery act requires reporting on qualified student trips
- Annual report deadline might be pushed back by one week, waiting for an official announcement
- Updates on budget
 - P-cards are suspended, must do a purchase order
 - Only essential purchases are allowed, addressing essential health and safety, essential to fulfilling campus mission, provide a future benefit
 - This does not include foundation money
 - Next year OTPS budgets are unknown, expect a manageable cut
- Fall 2020 opening

 - All options are being considered
 - Reduce reliance on adjuncts
