- Update from PAC guests from SUNY to discuss print initiative
  - o working with IT staff and budget
  - Goal to reduce cost, eliminate underutilized printers, discourage color, encourage

  - Maybe save \$15-20 million SUNY, Cortland could save \$270-400k
  - Brockport was one-of-three pilot campuses
  - No one will confiscate your printer
  - o Time-frame is about 120 days

#### **New Business**

Program Standard GPA
