The Club Constitution Committee reserves the right to support or oppose recognition of a potential club to the Senate. The following are reasons the Club Constitution Committee would oppose recognition:

1. It does not have an education purpose.
2. It is similar to a club or organization which is already recognized.
3. It is detrimental to the campus community in that
4. It will not benefit or is harmful to the students and community
5. It interferes with the Students Code of Conduct
6. It is discriminatory in any way....(race, sex, religion, age, national origin, disability, or veteran status)
